Alexander graduated at the top of his class from Georgetown University's School of Medicine, Washington DC; he honorably served as an officer in the Unites States Air Force where he was identified as the #1 doctor in his program, and is currently Chief of Plastic Surgery at Mountain View Hospital. He enjoys private practice as well as working with some of the finest doctors in the community.
